



Guidelines for Mask-making & Drop-off

Sewing guidance:

- If you have all of the materials you need and have more advanced skills, it can take 12-20 minutes to make a mask. With that said, elastic is hard to come by. If you are sewing ties, that will add an additional 20 minutes. Bias tape or ACE bandages can be used as substitutes for elastics.

- Trying to complete one mask at a time also increases time. Setting up your work space in an assembly line fashion helps speed up the process. So, we suggest: cut all fabric and elastics for each mask; pin each one; complete first round of sewing; complete final finishing.

Packaging and Drop Off:

- Put all masks in sealed ziplock bags.
- Please include your name, contact information, and amount of masks on your bag.
